<p>Diagnosis R 62.8 lack of expected normal physiological development and R62.0 delayed milestone are sometimes used for patients &gt; 18 years. Our coding experts mean this is correct coding, but the grouping result is DRG 470.</p> <p>We therefore suggest that 00P02 is removed from R62.8.</p> <p>After the change the patients are grouped to DRG's for outpatient consultations - in Norway DRG 9100.</p>
